


# Our streams, rivers, & lakes are not clean enough.



Most water bodies within Rockdale County are not clean enough for drinking, fishing, or recreational use. In fact, several water bodies are so polluted, that the State of Georgia considers them to be impaired (i.e. damaged, unusable).

The Rockdale County Stormwater Utility's primary goal is to protect our water bodies, by reducing the amount of pollutants in stormwater runoff.

## What can you do to help?

- Get involved! Join a community cleanup event, or volunteer to mark storm drains with emblems that read, "No dumping, drains to stream."
- Spread the word: Only rain should go down the storm drains!
- Maintain your septic system.
- Whenever possible, wash your car on the grass (it filters pollutants), or use water-recycling commercial car washes.
- Pick up your pet waste.
- Recycle and don't litter.
