

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT ELEMENT AS SUBMITTED TO AND APPROVED BY THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION AND GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS**

**WHEREAS**, Rockdale County prepared a Capital Improvements Element Plan under the 2018 minimum planning standards of the Georgia Department of Community Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, an update of the comprehensive plan, including a Capital Improvements Element is required for Rockdale County in order to maintain its Qualified Local Government Status; and

**WHEREAS**, Rockdale County prepared an update to its Capital Improvements Element; according to requirements set forth by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs Office of Planning and Quality Growth; and

**WHEREAS**, Requirements for the plan update specify each update must be submitted for regional and state review; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Commissioner submitted, as transmitted the Capital Improvement Plan to the Atlanta Regional Commission and The Georgia Department of Community Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has now received the approval from the Atlanta Regional Commission and approval of the Department of Community Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the it has been more than 60 days since the Capital Improvement Element was certified by the Atlanta Regional Commission as being complete; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners wishes to adopt the Capital Improvement Plan as submitted, reviewed and approved by the Atlanta Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Rockdale County, Georgia, that the Rockdale County Capital Improvement Plan, identified as Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by the reference, is hereby adopted and the Comprehensive Land Use Plan is hereby amended as described therein.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that any resolution in conflict with this resolution is hereby repealed.



# Capital Improvements Element

## 2018 Annual Update:

## FY 2017 Financial Report & Community Work Program

Rockdale County, Georgia

As Adopted October 9, 2018

## Introduction

This Capital Improvements Element Annual Update has been prepared based on the rules and regulations pertaining to impact fees in Georgia, as specified by the *Development Impact Fee Act* (DIFA) and the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) documents *Development Impact Fee Compliance Requirements* and *Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning*. These three documents dictate the essential elements of an Annual Update, specifically the inclusion of a financial report and a schedule of improvements.

According to the *Compliance Requirements*, the Annual Update:

“...must include: 1) the Annual Report on impact fees required under O.C.G.A. 36-71-8; and 2) a new fifth year schedule of improvements, and any changes to or revisions of previously listed CIE projects, including alterations in project costs, proposed changes in funding sources, construction schedules, or project scope.” (Chapter 110-12-2-.03(2)(c))

This Annual Update itself is based on the Rockdale County **Capital Improvements Element**, as amended by the County on **March 22, 2011**.

## Financial Report

The Financial Report included in this document is based on the requirements of DIFA, specifically:

“As part of its annual audit process, a municipality or county shall prepare an annual report describing the amount of any development impact fees collected, encumbered, and used during the preceding year by category of public facility and service area.” (O.C.G.A. 36-71-8(d)(1))

The County’s fiscal year runs from January 1 to December 31. Thus, the financial report included here is based on the audit prepared for FY 2017. The required financial information is shown on the table on page 2, and detailed information for each public facility category appears in the tables on pages 3 through 5.

*Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning*. The correct current description is found at Chapter 110-12-1-.04(2)(b)1.

## Schedule of Improvements

In addition to the financial report, the County has prepared a five-year schedule of improvements—a community work program (CWP)—as specified in the *Compliance Requirements* (Chapter 110-12-2-.03(2)(c)), which states that local governments that have a CIE must “update their entire Short Term [i.e., Community] Work Programs annually.”<sup>1</sup>

According to DCA’s requirements,<sup>2</sup> the CWP must include:

- A brief description of the activity;
- Legal authorization, if applicable;
- Timeframe for undertaking the activity;
- Responsible party for implementing the activity;
- Estimated cost (if any) of implementing the activity; and,
- Funding source(s), if applicable.

This information for impact fee eligible appears in the Community Work Program portion of this document, beginning on page 6.
