

**A RESOLUTION of Commitment by the Rockdale County Board of Commissioners To Provide Local Match To Federal Funding Awarded For Transportation Projects**

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) is currently accepting applications for federal funding for projects under the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program and the Transportation Alternatives Program for fiscal years 2022 through 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, world-class infrastructure, building a competitive economy and ensuring the region is comprised of healthy, livable communities are the principles of the Atlanta Region’s Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Rockdale County has completed an update to its 2040 Comprehensive Transportation Plan which involved an unprecedented level of public outreach; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of public and stakeholder input, Rockdale County should prioritize transportation projects which improve vehicular travel, improve safety, encourage walking and biking and maintain a state of good repair; and

**WHEREAS**, Rockdale County has developed a list of transportation projects and investments entirely consistent with both the principles of the Atlanta Region’s Plan and the goals of the County’s Comprehensive Transportation Plan,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE** Rockdale County Board of Commissioners will provide at a minimum the required 20% match for the following projects should grant funds be awarded:

Priority 2 – Rockdale River Trail Extension Project	\$5,500,000	\$1,375,000
Priority 3 – Sigman Road Widening Phase 4	\$3,920,000	\$980,000
Priority 4 – Old Covington Highway Projects	\$4,800,000	\$1,200,000
Priority 5 – Sigman Road Widening Phase 3	\$2,400,000	\$600,000




