

TEMPORARY PERMITS ONSITE LIVING UNITS

In the event a residential dwelling is destroyed to such an extent to make it uninhabitable, the Public Services Director or his/her designee, is authorized to issue a temporary permit for an onsite self-contained recreational vehicle living unit during reconstruction of the dwelling.

This temporary permit shall be issued to the property owner and shall be for a period of sixty (60) days. After the initial sixty (60) day period, the permit may be extended for thirty (30) day periods for a total of six (6) months.
