

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made by and between ROCKDALE COUNTY, GEORGIA, hereinafter called "County", and LUMIN8 TRANSPORTATION TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, a contractor doing business as a corporation of the City of Tucker, and State of Georgia, authorized to do business in Georgia, hereinafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH: that for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be made and performed by the **County**, the **Contractor** hereby agrees to perform the work and services in accordance with the conditions and prices stated in the proposal dated August 18, 2022 in response to ITB 22-31 when so requested by the **County**:

Furnish all labor, materials, and equipment, supervision, utility coordination, traffic control and all other requirements necessary to diagnose causes of malfunctions and perform necessary repairs to the Rockdale County traffic signals, school signal and flashing beacons when requested by the County, in consultation with the Rockdale County Director of Transportation or his designee in accordance with the Rockdale County and generally accepted industry practices and to utilize adequately trained and skilled technicians for the purpose of routine malfunction diagnosis, wiring, lamp maintenance, signal replacement and other related traffic signal or flashing beacons repairs; herein after referred to as the "Work", for and all extra work in connection therewith, under the terms as stated in the bid documents, and further detailed in the Minimum Specifications and Conditions for Traffic Signal Maintenance Services, and to furnish all materials, supplies, machinery, equipment, tools, superintendence, labor, and other accessories and services to complete the said "Work" in accordance with the conditions and prices stated in the proposal dated August 18, 2022 in response to ITB 22-31, hereinafter called the "Work", all of which are made a part hereof and collectively constitute the Contract. All Work is an on-call as needed basis and work will be authorized as Task Orders when needed.

Services will be among the **Contractor** and one (1) other contractor. The **Contractor** shall be ready to respond to requests for traffic signal, school signals, flashing beacon repairs or installation, in consultation with the Director of the Rockdale County Department of Transportation on a standby basis, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year.

The **Contractor** shall promptly commence the Work with adequate force and equipment within 3 hours from receipt of a request from the County, or as may be specified by Special Provision or direction by the County, and to complete the Work in a timely manner, or as may be specified by Special Provision.

The Contractor's role shall be one of an independent contractor and shall only perform services on behalf of the County when so requested by the County.

The **County** agrees to pay the **Contractor** in current funds for the performance of the Contract for work satisfactorily performed in accordance with the contract documents, and to make payments on account thereof as provided in the contract documents.

The contract period is (12) months from time of award, with up to 4 one-year extensions.

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

Each party hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party from any form of action, lawsuit or claim brought by or on behalf of the indemnifying party's employees, agents or invitees and related in any way to Product/Equipment/Services supplied by Contractor under this Agreement. Each party expressly agrees that the obligation of indemnity under this Paragraph extends to an action, lawsuit or claim alleging negligence of the indemnitee.

This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted according to the provisions of the laws of the State of Georgia.

For purposes of executing this Agreement and any Change Orders, electronic/scanned/photocopied signatures shall be as valid as the original.

IN WITNESS WHERE OF, the parties to those presents have executed this Contract in two (2) counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.
