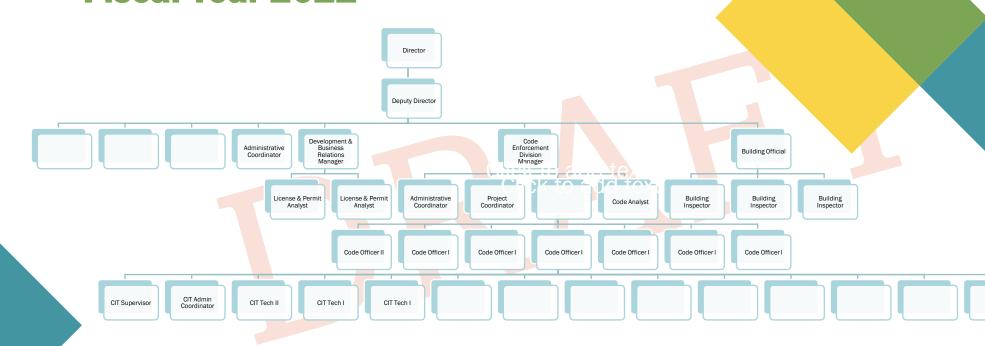

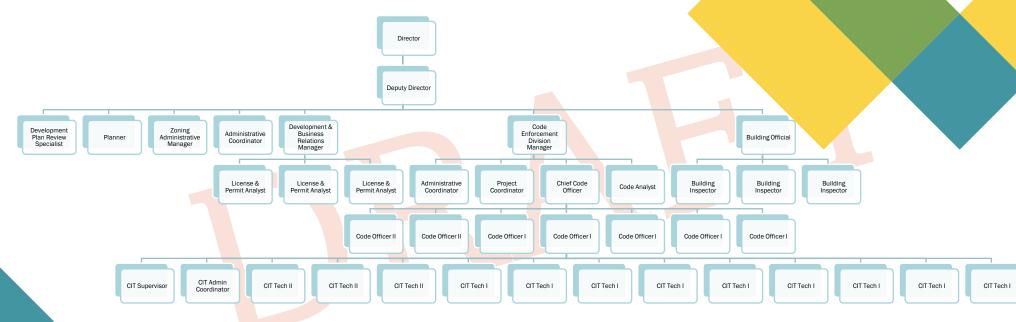
Current Organizational Chart Fiscal Year 2022
