


Current Organizational Chart

Request Justification

New Position Requests

Court Reporter

1 FTE - \$50,749 + Benefits at estimated 40 % additional

- During the past year, it has become a task to secure and keep a court reporter. We have found based on research that
 most are drawn to private court reporting firms, larger counties and Superior Court based on appearance fees and the
 greater need for transcripts. We are currently offering \$300 per DM on an average of 72 hearings a year to include
 transcripts by request as needed, which generates additional revenue for the court reporter. The current rate is not
 appealing to most, which makes it almost impossible to ensure that we follow Georgia State Law with regards to having
 a court reporter. Having this position approved would enable us to compete with the market rates.
- Court reporters are attracted to permanent positions that provide them job security. Thus, several jurisdictions are currently offering the said option making it difficult to secure court reporters as required. The addition of a permanent court reporter position would relieve this court of the challenges associated with finding available court reporters to ensure we comply with the law.
