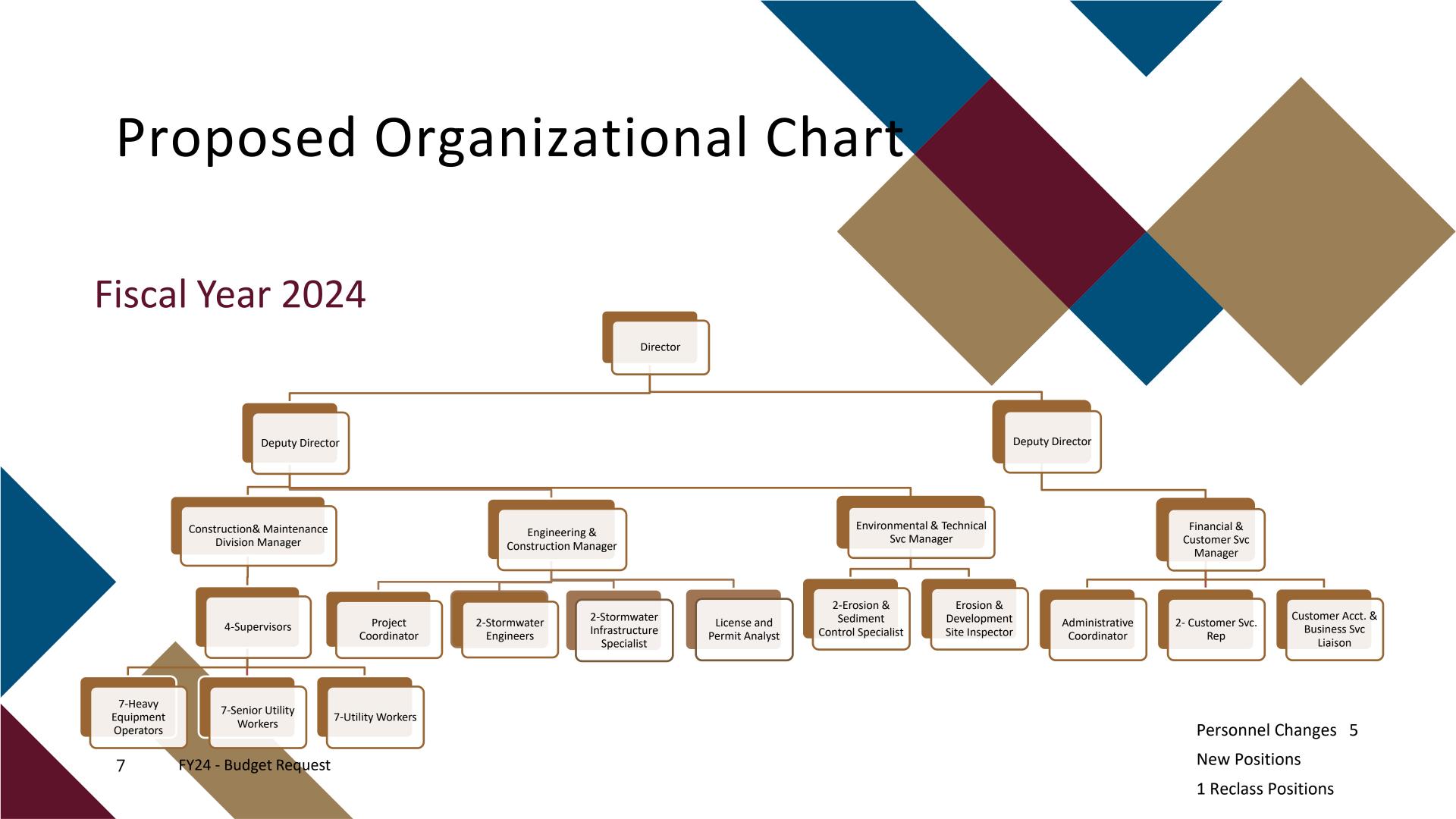

## HEAVY EQUIPMENT

o 2024 Dump Truck

\$192,000

- Used to haul trash and debris and deliver gravel, rip-rap for infrastructure repair projects
- 2025 Vac Truck

\$850,000

 Due to the current vac-truck continuing maintenance issues and cost.
