General Provisions

- 1. It is expressly stipulated that this permit is a license for permissive use only, and the placing of the facilities upon public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or vest any property right in the holder.
- Prior to the initiation of any work under this permit, the applicant shall determine the location of any and all other installations for utilities upon, over or across the right-of-way and shall install, operate and maintain the facilities in such a manner as not to damage or interfere with the operation of its existing facilities.
- 3. Whenever necessary for the construction, repair, improvement, maintenance, safe and effective operation, alteration or relocation of all or any portions of the roadway, as determined by Rockdale County, any and all of said facilities and appurtenances authorized hereunder shall be immediately removed from the right-of-way, or reset or relocated thereon, as required by Rockdale County, and at the sole expense of the permittee unless reimbursement is authorized by separate agreement. Should the permittee fail to remove or relocate its facilities, upon due notice from the County, the permittee shall be liable for any extraordinary costs or damages incurred by Rockdale County as a result thereof.
- 4. Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Rockdale County and all officers, Employee's or agents of Rockdale County or any political subdivision thereof, against any and all claims, damages, demands, actions, causes of action and expenses of whatsoever nature, which may result from any injury to, or the death of, any person or from the loss of, or damage to, property of any kind or nature, on such entry, death, loss or damages arises out of this construction, operation, maintenance, repair ,removal or relocation of the facilities covered by this permit.
- 5. Rockdale County, Its Engineers, officers or employees shall not be held responsible or liable for any injury or damage that may occur to facilities covered by this permit or to any connection thereto, by reason of roadway maintenance and construction activities or roadways contractors or permittee operations. Rockdale County's contractor shall not be held liable for any damage that may occur to utility facilities if the permittee has been notified of a construction conflict and given reasonable time to mark or relocate its facilities but has failed to do so.
- 6. If Rockdale County undertakes to improve this roadway, it shall be the responsibility of the permittee to plan with Rockdale County and its contractor a schedule which will clearly set forth at which stage of operations the permittee will be required to perform any adjustment to its facilities necessary to accommodate roadway improvements.
- 7. During the initial installation or construction of facilities authorized by this permit, or during any future repair, removal or relocation thereof, or any miscellaneous operations, this permittee shall at all times maintain flagmen, signs, lights, flares, barricades, and other safety devices in accordance with the manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and may be necessary to properly protect traffic upon the roadway and to warn and safeguard the public against injury or damage.
- 8. It is the Applicants responsibility to verify the limits of public right-of-way for location of the utility facilities authorized hereby.
- 9. No Inherent or retained right of privilege of any abutting property owner is affected by this permit nor is Rockdale County responsible for any claim which may develop between the permittee and property owner concerning the use of the right-of-way. Permittee is responsible for maintain reasonable access to the private driveways during installation of its facilities and for restoration of driveways to the owners satisfaction.
- Approval of this permit does not constitute approval of design or construction details for the purposed facilities. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all applicable governmental codes and regulations.
- 11. Use of explosives within the roadbed or beneath the pavement is prohibited unless approved by separate permit.
- 12. Applicant shall be responsible for obtaining approvals for the purposed installation which may be required by any local government on roads or streets under their jurisdiction or by any other agency.
- 13. Permittee shall give Rockdale County, through its office of Transportation, a minimum of 24 hours' notice prior to beginning any work under this permit.
- 14. This permit shall be void unless work hereunder is begun within ninety (90) days of its approval.
- 15. The provisions of this permit are regulatory and not contractual. No interest or right of any applicant granted by this permit may be transferred to another except by written consent of Rockdale County.
- 16. This permit may be revoked with or without cause by Rockdale County upon thirty (30) days written notice to permittee.
- 17. Any utility cut made within the roadbed of any paved county road shall be replaced as required by Rockdale County. In addition, said cut shall be plated until such time as the concrete has cured to design compressive stress and properly asphalted.
- 18. Upon Completion of work, the permittee shall sign this permit and return to the Department of Transportation
- 19. This permit covers work ONLY within Rockdale County Right of Way (ROW). Applicant must obtain ROW permission for any and all work to be performed in surrounding jurisdictions (i.e. GDOT, City of Conyers, Dekalb County, Newton County etc.). Please provide RDOT with parcel numbers and clear delineation of the intended construction limits within Rockdale County and only depict work within our county to expedite processing.
