



Resolution Declaring a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, Rockdale County, Georgia has experienced an event of critical significance as a result of tornados and severe storms commencing on the 2nd day of April 2024 at 11:00 p.m. and.

WHEREAS, there exist emergency circumstances requiring extraordinary and immediate corrective acts for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Rockdale County, Georgia, and;

WHEREAS, to prevent or minimize injury to people and damage to property resulting from this event;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Rockdale County, Georgia hereby declares that a local state of emergency exists, and;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Rockdale County Emergency Management Agency retroactively and actively maintain the Rockdale County Emergency Operations Plan, and;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the emergency management ordinances adopted by the Rockdale County Board of Commissioners and any other applicable government agencies or authority including, but not limited, to the State of Georgia and the Georgia Emergency Management Agency or those incorporated in said emergency plan become activated until such time declared by the Rockdale County, Georgia and the Rockdale County Emergency Management Agency.
